



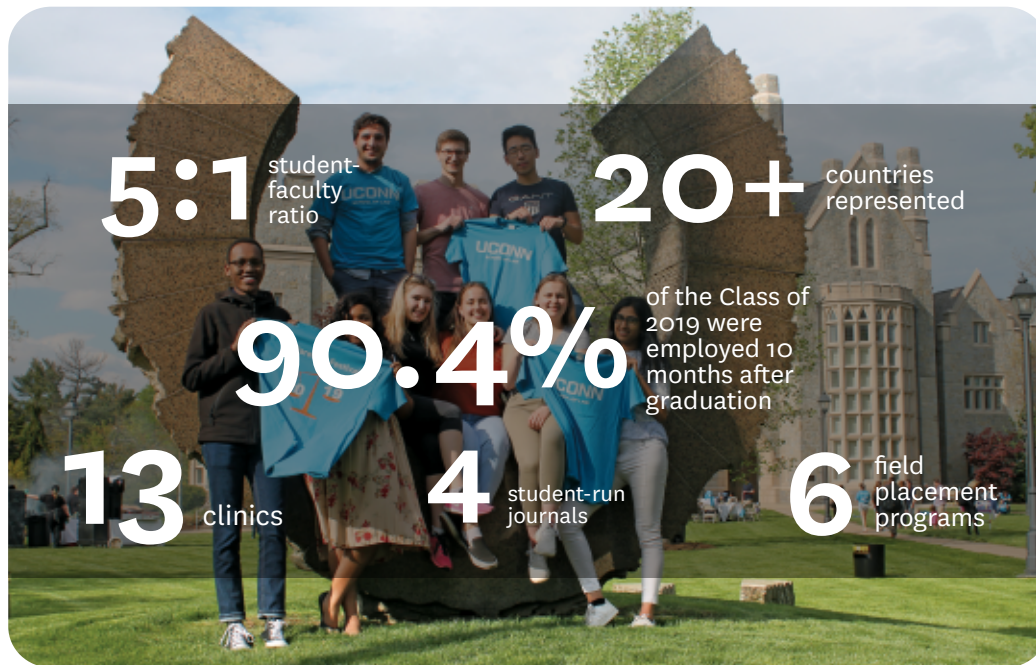

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must hold or expect to receive a degree from an ABA-approved law school or from a recognized law faculty outside the United States before matriculating in the LLM program at UConn School of Law. Applicants must supply:

- Personal statement and writing sample
- Resume or CV
- TOEFL, IELTS or PTE language test results
- Two recommendation letters
- All degree transcripts

THREE TIPS FOR YOUR PERSONAL STATEMENT

- **Length:** 1-2 pages
- **Showcase information that is not elsewhere in your application**
- **Tell your story**
